Turn on the switch located on the side of the Tri-Test to turn on the UV light used to locate security stripes

Turn on the switch located on the side of the Tri-Test to turn on the LED light used to locate watermarks

A Classic Counterfeit Detection Pen is located in a pocket on the right-hand side of the Tri-Test

Ink Guide:

1. Draw a prominent line on the suspicious bill
2. Light yellow line will appear on legitimate currency and eventually disappear after time
3. Dark mark will appear on fake bill

Use the UV light to locate security stripes. A convenient guide on the front of the unit show you the color and location for each denomination \$5 and higher.

Use the LED light to locate watermarks. These should mirror the portrait in the center of the bill. (on the \$5, the numeral 5 appears, not an image of Lincoln)



You've been given a counterfeit...Now what?

Once you've determined that you've received a counterfeit bill make sure to turn in the bill to your local police station or U.S. Secret Service field agency

Several of the provisions in the federal counterfeiting law provide for a fine of up to \$250,000 and a prison sentence of up to twenty years for the counterfeiting of U.S. obligations and securities.
